



Rules of the 144 MHz e M[ost] W[anted] S[quares] Europe and 144MHz e M[ost]-W[anted]-DXCC

Dear VHF friends,

as you noticed the last survey for the 144 MHz M[ost] W[anted] S[quares] in Europe was evaluated by the German Magazines "DUBUS" and "Funk-Telegramm" by Joe, DL8HCZ and published on Guido´s, DL8EBW´s homepage:

as we was doing this since the past 10-15 years...

Since the begin of the year 2007, the VHF-DX-Portal of

Make More Miles on VHF (**<http://www.mmmonvhf.de>**)

was in contact with Joe, DL8HCZ, to develop this survey on a more comfortable way for our users and us editors.

So in 2007 we did start to be online with the always up to date

144 MHz e M[ost] W[anted] S[quares] Survey Europe

From now on you are be able to upload your own MWS-files "ONLINE" without the need of any emailing or any deadline missing anymore. Of course you are still also welcome to send in your MWS sheets to the editor of DUBUS or/and MMMonVHF!

You are still able to use the well known VQ-Log "MWS output" tables as well as simple text files. THERE IS NO NEED OF A SPECIFIC PROGRAM ANYMORE!

Once per year Joachim DL8HCZ / CT1HZE and Guido, DL8EBW will of course personally remind you to update the Most Wanted Square List and once per year in advance of the new MS/ES Saison DUBUS and Funk-Telegramm will print the evaluated datas at a fixed date mid of march to show you and all expeditionärs which Squares and DXCCs might be welcome to activate...

So what is necessary to take part at the 144 MHz e M[ost] W[anted] S[quares] and DXCC Survey

First, you need to "Login" at your User Account of the MMonVHF page.

Put in your Call and Passwort (or make your new Account if you haven't one up to now) and after click on "Click here to go directly to your account data". Then click at the "eMWS Upload" button. You have now the possibility to upload your MWS data file (right area of these columnne).

RULES:

Everybody can send in as many most wanted squares as he wants. Of course it shall be necessary that the wanted squares have to be in a reachable area from the senders QTH. We do recommend following QRB:

600-800	km	for stations working tropo propagations only
800-1000	km	for stations which also want to work WET-SQUARES (eg. JO15)
2000-2300	km	for stations working all propagations like MS, ES and EME

Example:

If you are qrv on 144 MHz only tropo you might send a list of squares in a range of 600-800 km around your QTH. If you qrv also MS/ES/EME you might send in a list of squares in range of maximum 2300 km.

Also all "wet" squares are possible to activate but shall be within a extended tropo range. Its your decision if you count only "not worked square", or if you add the squares pending on confirmation.

Upload:

Please select which type of MWS file you are using. Here you have two possibilities. The prefered method to send in your entry for the survey will the output file from VQ-Log (EA6VQs Logbook program) but also a simple "Manual" or "text" file (with the extension, which has to be ".txt") will do it as well:

Manual TEXT-file (eg. DL8EBW_MWS2008.txt) format:
